Name of picture, self-explanatory. Can only be one. I changed from scene because it makes more sense.

Location: I rethought what you can really tell from a picture and I chose to make this that be optional and with multiple entries. Sometimes you can't tell where a house is, other times it's a well known landmark.

Technical: any technical architectural information, keeping in mind the user group audience. For example, building materials, types of roofs, windows etc.

Style or Historical Period: I made this category more inclusive so that by looking a the picture you could list either it's obvious style that it was built in or the historical period that it was built in or built to look like (which in my opinion would make it a style). I've made it repeatable and optional since it would be possible to have a historical period as well as a style for a building. I also chose the term historical period rather than year because it may just be a vague time period and you can't narrow it down with out more information.

Function: I really thought about what important elements an architecture class would want to focus on. I thought function was really important. It's required (because every building has function, even if it's just decorative) and repeatable because buildings often have more than one function.
